11 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's pro hac vice applications. Upon review of the record  
12 in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a written consent to Magistrate Judge James'  
13 jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to Magistrate Judge James for all purposes  
14 including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this district court are  
15 designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and entry of final  
16 judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge  
17 James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same  
18 manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

19 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and  
20 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether it consents to Magistrate Judge  
21 James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of  
22 both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's  
23 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, choose "Forms" and then "Civil  
Forms." The consent/declination form shall be filed by June 16, 2011.
