Track I(b) trial has been continued to 7/22/13 and the pretrial is continued to 7/9/13 (7-1827, 10-4572, 10-4945, 10-5452, and 12-4114)

By 3/29/13, counsel shall submit a proposed pretrial scheduling order with respect to the Track I(b) cases.

As to Track I(b), there will be no ATM FEE evidentiary hearing.

T-Mobile and Defendants shall submit a stipulation to the 75 day extension, with revised dates. If T-Mobile seeks to reinstate certain indirect purchaser claims pursuant to the Ninth Circuit's *AT&T Mobility LLC v. AU Optronics Corp.* decision, it must submit a motion. The Court grants T-Mobile leave to submit such motion.
