Defendant RLRCO has failed to file a written consent to magistrate judge jurisdiction by the September 1, 2011 deadline. An appeal from a judgment entered by a magistrate judge may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and disposition. Accordingly, Defendant shall inform the Court whether it consents to magistrate judge jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial.
