**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

18 Defendants.  
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20 Defendants moved to dismiss the complaint (Dkt. No. 11). Pursuant to Civil Local Rule  
21 7-3, any brief in opposition to defendants' motion was due on July 22, 2011, but no such  
22 opposition was received. On July 26, plaintiff was ordered to show cause why the action should  
23 not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. Plaintiff was ordered to respond by August 19, but no  
24 response has been received. Plaintiff was explicitly warned: "If [he] does not respond by August  
25 19, this case will be dismissed for failure to prosecute." As plaintiff — after being clearly warned  
26 that dismissal was imminent — has failed to prosecute this action, it is **DISMISSED**. Judgment  
27 will be entered in favor of defendants and against plaintiff.
