10 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's pro hac vice application. Upon review of the record in
11 this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a written consent to magistrate judge
12 jurisdiction jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to the undersigned magistrate judge
13 for all purposes including trial. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this
14 district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and
15 entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by a
16 magistrate judge may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in
17 the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

18 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
19 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether it consents to magistrate judge
20 jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of both the
21 consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's website at
22 <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, choose "Forms" and then "Civil Forms." The
23 consent/declination form shall be filed by June 23, 2011.
