17	On November 14, 2014, the court certified two classes: a "Jason class" and an "Avalon	
18	Organics" class. (ECF Nos. 267 at 33, 269 at 33.) The court asked the parties to submit a joint	
19	statement with any changes to the definitions. (<i>Id.</i>) The parties did. (ECF No. 271.) Hain proposed	
20	(and Plaintiffs did not oppose) replacing the words "personal care product" with "cosmetic product."	
21	(<i>Id.</i>) The court does so and modifies the class definitions as follows:	
22	The Jason Class," defined as:	
23	All persons who purchased a cosmetic product in California sold under the Jason brand name between May 12, 2007 and January 31, 2011 other than those Jason brand cosmetic products that are USDA-certified as organic.

25	The "Avalon Organics Class," defined as:	
26	All persons who purchased a cosmetic product in California sold under the Avalon Organics brand name between May 12, 2007 and the present other than those Avalon Organics brand cosmetic products that are USDA-certified as organic.
