L.R. 3-9(b) (providing that "[a] corporation, unincorporated 20 association, partnership or other such entity may appear only through a member of the bar of this 21 Court"). ADS is forewarned that, should it fail to obtain counsel, then it will be found in default and 22 Plaintiff may seek entry of a default judgment against it. 23 Counsel shall ensure that a copy of this order is immediately served on the appropriate ADS 24 representative. provide the Courtroom Deputy with all contact information that he has for ADS. Counsel shall also have a continuing obligation to forward any papers received in conjunction with this litigation to the appropriate ADS representative.
