**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION TO RESCHEDULE THE
CASE MANAGEMENT
CONFERENCE (Dkt. No. 29)**

Now before this Court is Plaintiff's ex parte motion to reschedule the case management conference currently set for February 2, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. and to amend the briefing schedule for his pending motions.
