On July 13, 2011, while plaintiff was incarcerated at the Alameda County Jail, he filed the instant civil action. The court notified plaintiff in writing at that time that the action was deficient because plaintiff did not pay the requisite \$350.00 filing fee or, instead, submit a signed and completed court-approved prisoner's in forma pauperis application, including a completed certificate of funds in the prisoner's account and a copy of the prisoner's trust account statement for the last six months. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). Plaintiff was advised that failure to file the requested items within 30 days would result in dismissal of the action.

The court's mail to plaintiff was returned as undeliverable several times. But on November 2, 2011, plaintiff notified the court that he was no longer in custody and that mail to him should be sent to his private residence in Milpitas, California.
