ORDER REGARDING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION FOR ACCESS TO LAW
LIBRARY

12 Plaintiff David Maurice Gomez, a state prisoner
13 incarcerated at Salinas Valley State Prison (SVSP), filed this
14 civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 regarding incidents that
15 took place at SVSP. On June 20, 2013, the Court referred this case
16 to Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas for settlement proceedings and
17 stayed the case pending the outcome of those proceedings.

18 On July 5, 2013, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting
19 "immediate access to law library in preparation for settlement
20 proceedings." In this motion, Plaintiff indicated that he had
21 showed "the Court's orders," docket numbers 49 and 74, to the law
22 librarian who denied Plaintiff access to the law library because
23 she determined that the documents were falsified.

24 Docket numbers 49 and 74 are not orders of the Court;
25 they are motions filed by Defendants and by Plaintiff. It is
26 possible that the law librarian thought they were false because
27 Plaintiff represented that they were Orders of the Court and they
