Pursuant to Rule 16(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the parties attended a Case Management Conference on March 8, 2012. After considering the Joint Case Management Statement submitted by the parties and consulting with the attorneys of record for the parties and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. DISCOVERY. On or before August 13, 2012, all non-expert discovery shall be completed by the parties.

2. EXPERT WITNESSES. The disclosure and discovery of expert witness opinions shall proceed as follows:

A. On or before September 12, 2012, plaintiffs shall disclose expert testimony reports in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(2).

B. On or before October 12, 2012, defendants shall disclose expert testimony and reports in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(2).

C. On or before December 11, 2012, all discovery of expert witnesses pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(b)(4) shall be completed.
