14 By court order filed on August 15, 2011, this case was set for an initial Case Management  
15 Conference on November 29, 2011 at 10:00 a.m., with a Case Management Conference statement  
16 due on November 22, 2011. Plaintiff, who is representing herself, filed letters on August 30, 2011  
17 and October 17, 2011 informing the Court that she was resolving this matter with Defendant and  
18 would dismiss her case when the agreement was finalized. Plaintiff did not ask for a continuance of  
19 the Case Management Conference. After a call from the Court after her Case Management  
20 Conference statement was not timely filed, Plaintiff filed a Case Management Conference statement  
21 on November 23, 2011. Plaintiff filed a request to continue the Case Management Conference on  
22 November 28, 2011, the afternoon before the scheduled Case Management Conference, even though  
23 the Local Rules require that any request to continue a scheduled hearing be filed no later than  
24 fourteen days before the hearing. See Civil L.R. 6-1(b). On November 29, 2011, the Court denied  
25 Plaintiff's request to continue. Plaintiff did not appear on November 29, 2011 for the Case  
26 Management Conference. Further, there has been no showing that Plaintiff has served Defendant  
27 with the summons and complaint in this case in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4.


Accordingly, Plaintiff is ordered to show cause as to why this case should not be dismissed  
without prejudice for failure to prosecute pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).

Plaintiff's written response to this Order to Show Cause shall be due no later than December 9, 2011.  
A show cause hearing is scheduled for December 20, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom E, 15th floor,  
450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, CA. It is further ordered that if Plaintiff fails to file a  
response to this Order to Show Cause by December 9, 2011, the Court will dismiss this action  
without prejudice for failure to prosecute.
