21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between Plaintiff Daniel Butler (“Plaintiff”) and  
 22 Defendant Federal Express Corporation, through their respective counsel, and subject to approval by  
 23 the Court, propose that the Further Settlement Conference currently scheduled for August 3, 2012 at  
 24 10:00 AM be continued to August 31, 2012, at a time to be set by the Court. Plaintiff has verified  
 25 that all parties and the Court are available on August 31, 2012. The scheduling of this Further  
 26 Settlement Conference is not subject to any timeline imposed by Judge White of the District Court.
