1 Plaintiff Yolanda Byrd and Defendant Patrick Donahoe, Postmaster General for the
2 United States Postal Service, respectfully submit this Stipulation and [Proposed] Scheduling
3 Order extending discovery and hearing deadlines in the above-captioned matter.
