Inc., 813 F.2d 1532, 1534–1536 (9th Cir. 1987) (Rule 41(a)(1)(I) does not require leave of court to dismiss the action). The dismissal is without prejudice. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1). The order of service (Docket No. 5) is VACATED. The Clerk shall terminate Docket No. 6, enter judgment in favor of defendants, and close the file.
