Although petitioner previously requested this stay pending the resolution of a similar claim in another capital case in this District, Ashmus v. Davis, C 93-594, he now would like to have this stay lifted in order to avoid piecemeal litigation of his petition, especially in light of the fact that he intends to proceed with discovery. Respondent agrees with petitioner's request, but asks that the Court set due-dates for the filing a traverse on claim 1 and for the filing of a discovery motion.

Accordingly, the Court rules as follows:

- 1) Petitioner's request to lift the stay imposed on claim 1 is granted.
- 2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, petitioner shall file a supplemental traverse addressing claim 1, as well as a motion for discovery.
