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1 1. Plaintiffs filed the Complaint in this case on September 20, 2011. On December 9, 2 2011, Defendant filed a Motion to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, to Transfer to the Southern 3 District of New York. The Motion has been fully briefed and oral argument is scheduled for 4 February 17, 2012.

5 2. The Parties wish to engage in settlement discussions, have indicated a desire to 6 schedule an early settlement conference with a Magistrate Judge, and have an ADR phone 7 conference set for February 14, 2012. In addition, the Parties have reason to believe that limited 8 discovery from certain non-party entities will allow the Parties to engage in meaningful settlement 9 discussions. Upon entry of the requested Stay, the Parties have agreed to informally exchange 10 certain information and will further seek to obtain other information relevant to this litigation and their settlement discussions from several non-party entities.
