**ORDER OPENING DISCOVERY
PERIOD AND CONTINUING CASE
MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

14 The scheduling order in this matter provided that, “[a]bsent an agreement of the parties to
15 the contrary, discovery shall not commence prior to August 27, 2015.” The parties have now
16 agreed to begin exchanging discovery. They are free to do so.


17 Discovery disputes will be referred to a Magistrate Judge. After the parties have met and
18 conferred, the parties shall prepare a joint letter of not more than 8 pages explaining the dispute.
19 Up to 12 pages of attachments may be added. The joint letter must be electronically filed under
20 the Civil Events category of “Motions and Related Filings >Motions--General > Discovery Letter
21 Brief.” The Magistrate Judge to whom the matter is assigned will advise the parties of how that
22 Judge intends to proceed. The Magistrate Judge may issue a ruling, order more formal briefing, or
23 set a telephone conference or a hearing. After a Magistrate Judge has been assigned, all further
24 discovery matters shall be filed pursuant to that Judge’s procedures.

25 The Case Management Conference previously scheduled for August 27, 2015 is continued
26 to November 5, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 3, 17th Floor, San Francisco. A joint Case
27 Management Statement must be filed on or before October 29, 2015.
