estimate of the number of days for trial. If the parties propose competing schedules, the Court is
very likely to choose whichever of the two proposals appears to be more reasonable rather than
attempting to reconcile the two proposals.

After receiving the case management statement, the Court will set the matter for a case
management conference if one appears to be necessary.
