Defendants shall have 7 days after the response is due to file a reply that is no longer 21 than 5 pages. The parties are to address only the above question. If the Court finds that the 22 motions for summary judgment cannot be resolved without oral argument pursuant to Local 23 Rule 7-1(b), it will set a hearing date in a future order. 24 25 IT IS SO ORDERED. 26 Dated: January 18, 2017 R.
