**ORDER ON PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO
CONTINUE TRIAL AND RELATED
DATES (DKT. 172)**

Plaintiff brought this motion for an order continuing the trial and related dates by three months. "A schedule may be modified for good cause and with the judge's consent." Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b)(4); see also Zivkovic v. S. Cal. Edison Co., 302 F.3d 1080, 1087 (9th Cir. 2002) ("the pretrial scheduling order can only be modified 'upon a showing of good cause'"). "Good cause" is shown when the pretrial schedule "cannot reasonably be met despite the diligence of the party seeking the extension." Id. (quoting Johnson v. Mammoth Recreations, Inc., 975 F.2d 604, 607 (9th Cir. 1992)). For the reasons stated at the July 29, 2014 hearing, and good cause being shown, Plaintiff's motion is hereby GRANTED as modified below:

Opening expert reports	October 22, 2014
Rebuttal expert reports	November 14, 2014
Completion of expert discovery	November 21, 2014
Deadline to file summary judgment motions	December 19, 2014
Summary judgment hearing	February 17, 2015

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Motions in limine and joint pretrial statement	March 16, 2015
Pretrial conference	April 14, 2015
Trial	May 4, 2015
