This is a federal civil rights action filed by a *pro se* state prisoner pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. By order of the Court, plaintiff was granted 30 days (1) to file a complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”), or (2) to pay the filing fee of \$350.00, or face dismissal of the action. More than 30 days have passed and plaintiff has not filed an IFP application or paid the filing fee. Accordingly, the action is DISMISSED without prejudice to plaintiff filing a complete IFP application or paying the filing fee. The Clerk shall enter judgment in favor of defendant and close the file.
