13 On December 3, 2012, defendant filed a motion for summary judgment. A hearing was set for
14 January 25, 2013, and plaintiff's opposition was due December 17, 2012. Plaintiff did not file an
15 opposition, request an extension of time, or otherwise communicate in any other way with the Court.

16 **Accordingly, plaintiff is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE in writing no later than January**
17 **25, 2013, why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute.** See Fed. R. Civ. Proc.
18 41(b). Plaintiff's failure to respond to this Order will be treated as an acknowledgment of non-
19 opposition to defendant's motion for summary judgment. The January 25, 2013 is VACATED.
