**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS’
MOTION TO CONTINUE THE
HEARING ON PLAINTIFFS’ MOTION
TO COMPEL**

The district court has referred Plaintiffs’ motion to compel a response from a nonparty to a subpoena for records and all future discovery matters to this Court for determination. Doc. No. 4.
