22 Pursuant to paragraph 4 of this Court’s April 10, 2012 Order Setting Case Management

3 inconveniently scheduled. *See id.* ¶ 4.
- 4 3. Undersigned counsel for defendants will be traveling at taxpayer expense from  
5 Washington, D.C., to San Francisco for a CMC set for June 29, 2012, at 1:30 p.m. in  
6 *County of Santa Cruz, et al. v. Sebelius*, No. 3:07-2888-JSW (N.D. Cal.). The parties  
7 agree that, to conserve the taxpayers' resources, it would be more convenient for  
8 undersigned counsel for defendants to set both this Court's CMC and that CMC for  
9 the same day.
- 10 4. Pursuant to Civil L.R. 6-2(a)(2), the parties agree that this is the first extension of  
11 time sought by defendants in this matter. Pursuant to Civil L.R. 6-2(a)(3), the parties  
12 further agree that rescheduling the CMC will affect the date set for the CMC, but  
13 have confirmed that the new time is convenient for the Court's calendar.

14 Accordingly, for good cause shown, this Court should reschedule the Case Management  
15 Conference to Friday, June 29, 2012, at 8:30 a.m.


