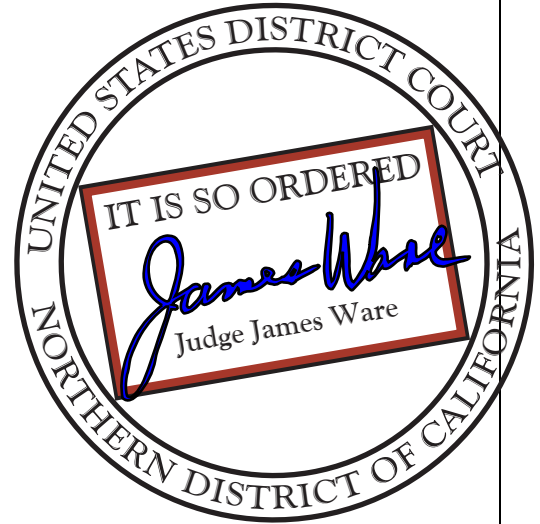

1 Plaintiff Mee Yong Lim (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Zep Inc. (“Zep”)
2 (collectively, “the parties”), if permitted by the Court, hereby stipulate to extend the
3 deadline to hold an ADR session that is currently set for October 19, 2012 to
4 November 30, 2012. In support of this stipulation to extend the ADR session
5 deadline, the parties declare as follows:

6 1. Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, on May 5, 2012, the Court
7 ordered the October 19, 2012 deadline to conduct private ADR in this matter.

8 2. The parties have been cooperating to select a mediator that is mutually
9 acceptable to the parties and have selected Judge Edward Infante from JAMS in San
10 Francisco.

11 3. The parties believe that Judge Infante will serve as the appropriate
12 mediator due to his experience mediating complex cases and because of his
13 experience as former Chief Magistrate Judge for the Northern District of California.
14 Judge Infante also has extensive experience mediating class action disputes, including
15 consumer class action disputes.

16 4. The instant matter involves a consumer class-action complaint, which
17 involves claims under the California Consumers Legal Remedies Act, False
18 Advertising Law, and Unfair Competition Law. Plaintiff’s Amended Complaint also
19 seeks injunctive relief.

20 5. Due to the nature of the claims, the parties believe that Judge Infante will
21 serve as the appropriate mediator who can best facilitate a meaningful ADR session.

22 6. The parties have been advised by JAMS that Judge Infante does not have
23 an open mediation appointment prior to the current mediation deadline of October 19,
24 2012. The parties have been informed, however, that Judge Infante has availability in
25 November.

1 7. The parties, therefore, necessitate a brief extension to the current ADR
2 deadline of October 19, 2012 to November 30, 2012 so that they may schedule and
3 confirm a mediation appointment with Judge Infante.

4 8. There have been no previous modifications of time in this case. This
5 deadline extension will not affect other deadlines, such as the close of discovery, the
6 last day for hearing dispositive motions, and the date of the preliminary pretrial
7 conference, set by the Court.

9 The parties respectfully request that the Court enter the Proposed Order for the
10 reasons set forth above.


