- 3. On or about March 29, 2012, Defendant sent a letter to Plaintiffs' counsel to refute 1 2 the findings of the audit. He stated that he had paid the travel time and gas mileage portion of the 3 audit along with the wages. Plaintiffs contacted Defendant for proof of payment.
- 4. 4 Defendant finally submitted the requested documentation in late July. The Trust 5 Funds' auditor has been working with Defendant to make final determinations as to the amounts due and compile a final draft of the audit correctly detailing the amounts Defendant owes the Trust 6 Funds. 7
- 5. 8 Defendant has recently indicated to Plaintiffs that he will be willing to enter into a 9 payment plan with Plaintiffs once the audit is completed, though the details of the payment plan 10 have not been finalized at this time.
- 6. Accordingly, Plaintiffs herein respectfully request that the Case Management 11 12 Conference, currently scheduled for October 12, 2012, be continued for sixty (60) days to allow 13 for the audit to be completed and a payment plan to be finalized with Defendant. If an agreement as to a payment plan cannot be reached, Plaintiffs will file a Motion for Default Judgment. 14
- 7. There are no issues that need to be addressed by this Court at the currently 15 scheduled Case Management Conference. In the interest of conserving costs as well as the Court's 16 time and resources, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court continue the currently scheduled 17 Case Management Conference. 18
