## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTORNEYS COMPLETING CIVIL COVER SHEET FORM JS 44

## Authority For thivil Cover Sheet

The JS 44 civil cover sheet and the infarmation cantained herein neither replaces nor supplements the filings and service of pleading or other papers as required by law, except as provided by lacal rules of court. This farm, approved ty the Judicial Conference of the United States in September 1974, is required for the use of the Clerk of Court for the purpose of initiating the civil docket sheet. Consequently, a civil cover sheet is submitted to the Clerk of Court for each civil complaint filed. The attorney filing a case should complete the form as follows:

- 1. (a) Plaintiffs-Defendants. Enter names (last, first, middle initial) of plaintiff and defendant. If the plaintiff or defendant is a government agency, use only the full name or standard abbreviations. If the plaintiff or defendant is an afficial within a government agency, identify first the agency and then the afficial, giving both name and title.
- (b) County of Residence. For each civil case tiled, except U.S. plaintiff cases, enter the name of the caunty where the first listed plaintiff resides at the time of filing. (NOTE: In land condemnation cases, the county of residence of the "defendant" is the location of the tract of land involved.)
- (c) Attarneys. Enter the firm name, address, telephone number, and attorney of record. If there are several atturneys, list them on an attachment, no fing in this section "(see attachment)".
- 11. Jurisdiction. The basis of jurisdiction is set forth under Rule 8(a), F.R.C.P., which requires that jurisdictions he shawn in pleadings. Place an "X" in anc of the boxes. If there is more than ane basis af jurisdiction, precedence is given in the order shown helow.

United States plaintiff. (1) Jurisdiction based on 28 U.S.C., 1345 and 1348. Suits by agencies and afficers at the United States are included here,

United States defendant. (2) When the plaintiff is soing the United States, its officers or agencies, place an "X" in this box.

Federal questian. (3) This refers to suits under 28 U.S.C. 1331, where jurisdiction arises under the Constitution of the United States, an amendment to the Canstitution, an act of Congress or a treaty of the United States. In cases where the U.S. is a party, the U.S. plaintiff or defendant code takes precedence, and box 1 or 2 should be marked.

Diversity of citizenship. (4) This refers to suits under 28 U.S.C. 1332, where parties are citizens af different states. When Box 4 is checked, the citizenship of the different parties must be checked. (See Section III helow; federal question actions take precedence over diversity cases.)

- III. Residence (citizenship) of Principal Parties. This section of the JS 44 is to be completed if diversity of citizenship was indicated above. Mark this section for each principal party.
- 1V. Nature of Suit. Place an "X" in the appropriate hox. If the nature of suit cannot be determined, the sure the cause of action, in Section VI below, is sufficient to combine the deputy clerk or the statistical clerks in the Administrative Office to determine the nature of suit. If the cause fits more than one nature of suit, select the most definitive.
- Origia. Place an "X" in one of the seven hoxes.

Original Proceedings. (i) Cases which originate in the United States district courts.

Removed fram State Court. (2) Proceedings initiated in state courts may be removed to the district caurts under Title 28 U.S.C., Section 1441. When the petition fur removal is granted, check this han.

Itemanded from Appellate Caurt. (3) Check this hox for cases remunded to the district court for further action. Use the date of remand as the filing date.

Reinstated or Renpened. (4) Check this hoa far cases reinstated or reopened in the district court. Use the reapening date as the filing date.

Transferred from Another District. (5) For cases transferred under Title 28 U.S.C. Section 1404(a). Do not use this for within district transfers or multidistrict litigation transfers.

Multidistrict Litigation. (6) Check this bux when a mattidistrict case is transferred into the district under authority of Title 28 U.S.C. Section 1407. When this bax is checked, do not check (5) above.

Appeal to District Judge from Magistrate Judgment. (7) Check this bax for an appeal fram a magistrate judge's decision.

- VI. Cause of Action. Report the civil statute directly related to the cause of action and give a brief description of the cause. Do not cite jurisdictional statutes unless diversity.

  Enample: U.S. Civil Statute: 47 USC 553

  Brief Description: Unauthorized reception of cable service
- VII. Requested in Camplaint. Class Action. Place an "X" in this box if you are filling a class actian under Rule 23, P.R. Cy.P.

Demand. In this space enter the dollar amount (in thousands of dollars) being demanded or indicate ather demand such as a preliminary injunction.

Jury Demand. Check the appropriate box to indicate whether or not a jury is being demanded.

- VIII. Related Cases. This section of the JS 44 is used to reference related pending cases if any. If there are related pending cases, insert the docket numbers and the corresponding judge names for such cases.
- 1X. Divisional Assignment. In accordance with Civil L.R, 3-2(c) (f), select the apprapriate venue based apan the county in which a substantial part of the events ar amissians which give rise to the claim accurred or in which a substantial part of the property that is the subject of the action is situated.
