21	Defendant shall file two motions for summary judgment: one addressing Plaintiffs' pattern	
22	and practice and disparate impact theories, totaling 25 pages, and one addressing individual	
23	claims, totaling 35 pages. The Court further ORDERS that Plaintiffs are permitted to file	
24	oppositions of 25 and 35 pages, and Defendant is permitted to file replies of 15 and 21 pages
