**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS’
ADMINISTRATIVE MOTION TO FILE
UNDER SEAL
(Docket No. 159)**

Currently pending before the Court is Plaintiffs’ Administrative Motion to File Under Seal unredacted versions of the following documents, pursuant to Civil L.R. 7-11 and 79-5(d): Exhibits 1 - 4 to the Declaration of Alexander P. Owings in Support of Plaintiffs’ Responses in Opposition to Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. (“Wells Fargo”), Wells Fargo Insurance, Inc. (Wells Fargo Insurance”), and American Security Insurance Company’s Motions to Dismiss (“Exhibits”), and Plaintiffs’ Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Opposition to American Security Insurance Company’s Motion to Dismiss Third Amended Class Action Complaint (“Opposition”). Docket Nos. 158 and 159. Exhibits 1 - 3 contain agreements between Wells Fargo and American Security Insurance Company relating to “lender-placed insurance.” Exhibit 4 contains agreements between Wells Fargo and Wells Fargo Insurance, Inc., also relating to lender-placed insurance. Wells Fargo designated these documents as “Confidential,” pursuant to the Stipulated Protective Order (Docket No. 126). Docket No. 158. The redacted portions of the Opposition describe the content of these documents.

Pursuant to Civil L.R. 79-5(d) and (e), Wells Fargo and Wells Fargo Insurance have submitted a declaration establishing that the designated material is sealable. Docket No. 161.
