Defendants request clarification as to whether the claim was also dismissed as to defendant William Scott Page, the alleged alter ego of Wm. Page & Associate. This order clarifies that the December 11 order dismissed the breach of fiduciary duty claim as to both William Scott Page and Wm. Page & Associates, referring to the two collectively as "Lifeline."
