1 I, Charles T. Graves, declare as follows:

2 1. I am an attorney at law duly admitted to practice in the State of California and  
3 before this Court. I am a partner at Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati PC, counsel of record for  
4 Plaintiff. I am over 18 years of age and have personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this  
5 declaration. If called as a witness, I could and would testify competently to them. I provide this  
6 declaration in support of Plaintiff's Notice of Motion and Motion to Serve Foreign Defendants  
7 by Alternative Means.

8 2. Plaintiff's Complaint against Defendants Jayson Yanuaria ("Yanuaria") and JL4  
9 Web Solutions ("JL4") (collectively, "Foreign Defendants") was filed on April 5, 2012. (ECF  
10 No. 1).

11 3. The Summonses were issued on April 5, 2012. (ECF No. 3).

12 4. Plaintiff made two unsuccessful attempts to serve the Foreign Defendants with  
13 copies of the respective Summons, the Complaint, and other documents, by mail that the clerk  
14 addressed and sent to the Foreign Defendants and that required a signed receipt, pursuant to  
15 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(f)(2)(C)(ii).

16 5. Plaintiff made these service attempts at addresses Plaintiff gathered in the course  
17 of an investigation Plaintiff conducted prior to filing the Complaint.

18 6. Based on the information gathered in that investigation, at the times it attempted  
19 service, Plaintiff believed that Yanuaria and JL4 maintained and were associated with the  
20 respective physical addresses in the Philippines at which Plaintiff attempted to serve them.

21 7. Plaintiff has no information about any other physical addresses currently  
22 associated with either Yanuaria or JL4.

23 8. Based on information gathered in the pre-filing investigation, Plaintiff believes  
24 that Yanuaria is married to a woman named Maria "Lou" Lourdes Macabasco-Yanuaria.

25 9. Based on information gathered in the pre-filing investigation and subsequent  
26 investigative efforts, Plaintiff believes that Yanuaria is associated with certain email addresses  
27 including but not limited to jayanuaria@gmail.com, jayson.yanuaria@yahoo.com, and  
28 xyz\_jay@yahoo.com.
