2	1. On April 27, 2012, this Court entered a temporary restraining order ("TRO")				
3	enjoining Defendants University of California, The Regents of the University of California, Mark				
4	G. Yudof, Marye Anne Fox, Gary Matthews, Does 1-50, their employees, agents, servants,				
5	assigns, and all those acting in concert with them, including but not limited to, the San Diego				
6	Archaeological Center, from "changing in any manner the current condition and location of the				
7	La Jolla Skeletons, and associated funerary objects." The Court noted that "[i]n the highly				
8	unlikely event that a natural disaster or other act of God requires the University to relocate the				
9	Skeletons for the sake of preservation, contrary to defendants' concern, a finding of contempt is				
10	not a realistic prospect." (Docket No. 19.)				
11	2. To avoid burdening the Court and the parties with proceedings on an order to show				
12	cause, Defendants are willing to stipulate to this Court's entry of a preliminary injunction with the				
13	same terms as the TRO.				
14	THEREFORE, the parties stipulate to the entry of a preliminary injunction with the same
