
**ORDER VACATING MOTION

Before the Court is an Order to Show Cause why this action should not be remanded to state court for lack of subject matter jurisdiction because Plaintiffs and Wells Fargo may not be diverse parties within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. §§ 1348, 1332, and 1441(b)(2).
