Defendant Pfizer has filed a notice 21 of non-opposition to both filings (dkt. 41). 22 Good cause appearing therefor, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's Motion for an 23 Extension of Time; Plaintiff has until October 25, 2012 to provide the required evidence. 24 However, the Court DENIES Plaintiff's Motion Requesting Production. That Motion 25 appears to seek Plaintiff's medical records from various entities. Plaintiff likely already has 26 the right to his own medical records, and should be able to request them from those entities 27 directly. To the extent that court intervention is required, Plaintiff should seek subpoenas

from courts in the proper jurisdiction(s).
