Dkt. No. 31. The Zamoras have filed an opposition 21 22 brief that states under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56(d) that the Zamoras cannot present facts essential to justify their opposition. Dkt. No. 33 at 7-8. The brief, and 23 attached declaration of attorney James Martinez do not explain (1) how the unavailable 24 facts are "essential" to the opposition; and (2) whether the Zamoras were diligent in 25 26 pursuing discovery from the moving defendants before the fact discovery deadline in this case. For example, the brief, and attached declaration state that the City of San Francisco 27 has refused to produce video and audio tapes of the incident, Dkt. Nos. 33 at 8:8-10; 33-1 28 Case No. 12-cv-02734 NC

1	¶ 9, but do not submit any evidence establishing the existence of such materials, the specific
2	response by the City of San Francisco to the request for such materials, or the reason why
3	the Zamoras did not move to compel this discovery.
4	Accordingly, by July 30, 2013, the Zamoras may file a supplemental declaration,
5	which may be accompanied by attachments, seeking to establish that the unavailable facts
6	are essential and that they were diligent in pursuing this essential discovery.
7	IT IS SO ORDERED.
