**ORDER DENYING AS MOOT
DEFERRED PORTION OF PARTIES'
JOINT ADMINISTRATIVE MOTION
AND STIPULATION TO FILE UNDER
SEAL**

Before the Court are a Joint Administrative Motion and Joint Stipulation, both filed November 14, 2016, by which the parties seek leave to file under seal a USB drive containing material that, according to the parties, comprises the full scope of evidence relevant to the above-titled action.

On July 13, 2017, the Court issued an order granting in part and deferring ruling in part on the parties' joint motion, and, with regard to the materials as to which the Court deferred ruling, directed any party seeking sealing of those materials to file, no later than July 20, 2017, a declaration establishing a basis for sealing. On July 20, 2017, the parties filed a joint notice, wherein the parties "agree[d] that the documents identified in the July 13, 2017 order do not contain confidential information" and, in accordance therewith, publicly filed those documents as Exhibits A-E to their joint notice. (See Joint Notice, filed July 24, 2017, at 3:7-8, Exs. A-E.)

Accordingly, to the extent the parties initially sought an order sealing the documents attached as Exhibits A through E to their joint notice, their Joint Administrative Motion to file under seal is hereby DENIED as moot, and, as the non-confidential materials included on the USB drive have been filed in the public record, the USB drive

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and its contents may remain under seal.
