12	No later than January 7, 2013, Lloyds TSB Bank, PLC ("Lloyds") shall file a 5-page letter	
13	brief addressing the following issues:	
14	1. Which entities are Lloyds' "competitors" for purposes of its proposed definition of	
15	"expert," and why are these entities "competitors."	
16	2. Why the information Lloyds seeks to designate as "highly confidential" merits that	
17	level of protection.	
18	3. Should the court agree with Lloyds that the above provisions are appropriate, why	
19	should the protective order not include a fee-shifting provision if Plaintiffs	
20	successfully challenge Lloyd's designations of "highly confidential" materials and/or	
21	"competitors."	
22	The temporary protective order entered on December 6, 2012 (Dkt. No. 63) will continue to apply	
23	pending resolution of this new issue. The court will schedule a hearing if appropriate.
