16 Judgment as a Matter of Law and New Trial pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 50(b)
17 and 59(a);

18 WHEREAS, on September 3, 2015, Fujifilm filed a post-trial Motion for Prejudgment
19 Interest pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 59(e);

20 WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to a hearing date of December 9, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.
21 for the Court to hear Fujifilm’s Motion for Judgment as a Matter of Law and New Trial,
22 Fujifilm’s Motion for Prejudgment Interest, and Motorola’s Motion for Judgment as a Matter of
23 Law and New Trial; and

24 WHEREAS, the parties believe it appropriate to expand the time in which to file
25 oppositions and replies to the above-referenced motions;


