

1	(4) Identification of those Defendants who should attend any settlement conference		
2	in light of the allegations as to the current ownership of Plaintiffs' loan.		
3	The Parties need not submit written materials to the ADR Unit for the telephone conference.		
4	In preparation for the telephone conference, counsel for Plaintiffs shall do the following:		
5	(1) Review the loan documents and investigate the claims to determine whether they		
6	have merit.		
7	(2) If Plaintiffs are seeking a loan modification to resolve all or some of the claims,		
8	Plaintiffs shall prepare a current, accurate financial statement and gather all of the		
9	information and documents customarily needed to support a loan modification		
10	request. Further, Plaintiffs shall immediately notify the appropriate Defendants'		
11	counsel of the request for a loan modification.		
12	(3) Provide counsel for Defendants with information necessary to evaluate the prospects		
13	for loan modification, in the form of a financial statement, worksheet or application		
14	customarily used by financial institutions.		
15	In preparation for the telephone conference, counsel for Defendants shall do the		
16	following:		
17	(1) If Defendants are unwilling or unable to do a loan modification after receiving notice		
18	of Plaintiffs' request, counsel for Defendants shall promptly notify Plaintiffs to that		
19	effect.		
20	(2) Arrange for a representative of each Defendant with full settlement authority to		
21	participate in the telephone conference.		
22	The ADR unit will notify parties of the date and time the telephone conference will be		
23	held. After the telephone conference, the ADR Unit will advise the Court of its recommendation		
24	for further ADR proceedings. In the meantime, the October 4, 2012 hearing on Defendants'		
25	motions to dismiss and to strike claims is VACATED. The Court will reschedule the hearing after		
26	the ADR assessment and/or ADR proceedings are complete, if necessary.
