

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On February 8, 2013, plaintiff Gregory Scott Martinez failed to appear as ordered at a regularly-scheduled Case Management Conference. The Court, by order filed February 8, 2013, directed plaintiff to show cause, in writing and no later than February 22, 2013, why the above-titled action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. The Court advised plaintiff that if he failed to respond, the case would be dismissed pursuant to Rule 41(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
