**ORDER DIRECTING PLAINTIFFS TO

Plaintiffs are hereby advised that if they fail in the future to comply with the Court’s Standing Order to provide a chambers copy of each electronically-filed document, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from

1 the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely
2 provided to the Court.
