In early April, plaintiff served non-party Christopher Glass with document and deposition subpoenas issued by the Middle District of Florida (where Mr. Glass resides). Thus far, Mr. Glass has twice failed to appear for his deposition and has not produced any documents. On June 11, Mr. Glass filed a request *in propria persona* for a protective order in this action requesting “protection from harassment by Plaintiff” and that the subpoenas be quashed. On June 17, plaintiff filed an emergency motion in the Middle District of Florida requesting that Mr. Glass be compelled to appear for his deposition. Magistrate Judge Thomas Morris granted plaintiff’s motion after a telephonic hearing.


Assuming without deciding that the undersigned has jurisdiction to decide Mr. Glass’
