**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This is a federal civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 by a *pro se* state prisoner. By order of the Court, plaintiff was granted 30 days (1) to file a complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”), or (2) to pay the filing fee of \$350.00, or face dismissal of the action. More than 30 days have passed since the order was filed, and plaintiff has not filed a complete IFP application, nor paid the filing fee. Accordingly, the action is DISMISSED without prejudice. Any motion to reopen the action **must** contain (1) a complete IFP application and supporting documents, or (2) payment for the entire filing fee of \$350.00. The Clerk shall enter judgment in favor of defendant, and close the file.
