

1 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B) provides that in habeas cases, whenever "the court
2 determines that the interests of justice so require", representation may be
3 provided for any financially eligible person. Petitioner presented his claims
4 adequately, and they were not particularly complex. The interests of justice do
5 not require appointment of counsel.

6 **CONCLUSION**

7 1. The motion for a certificate of appealability (Docket No. 22) is
8 DENIED.

9 2. The motion to appoint counsel (Docket No. 23) is DENIED.
