24 declination to the jurisdiction of a magistrate judge by 5:00 p.m. on November 19.
25 Counsel is reminded that failure to follow the local rules and failure to comply with court
26 orders is proper grounds for dismissal. *See Hells Canyon Pres. Council v. U.S. Forest*
27 *Serv.*, 403 F.3d 683, 689 (9th Cir. 2005) (district court may dismiss an action in
28 accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) sua sponte for a plaintiff's failure
