22 the Court's standing orders, which are available at cand.uscourts.gov/jstorders.


23 The parties must take all necessary steps to conduct discovery, compel discovery, hire
24 counsel, retain experts, and manage their calendars so that they can complete discovery in a timely
25 manner and appear at trial on the noticed and scheduled dates. All counsel must arrange their
26 calendars to accommodate these dates, or arrange to substitute or associate in counsel who can.

27 Requests for continuance are disfavored. The court will not consider any event
28 subsequently scheduled by a party, party controlled witness, expert or attorney that conflicts with
