
**ORDER FOR RESPONSE TO
DEFENDANT'S UNTIMELY
OPPOSITION BRIEF**

Plaintiff Board of Trustees of the Bay Area Roofers Health & Welfare Trust Fund (“Board of Trustees”) has filed a Motion for Default Judgment (“Motion”), currently set for hearing on October 4, 2013.
