1 Plaintiffs/Counterdefendants Nextdoor.com, Inc. (“Nextdoor.com”) and Prakash

18 time in this action and to present any and all admissible evidence with respect to such a motion.

19 5. Nothing in this Stipulation shall be construed as an admission of liability or  
20 wrongdoing of any kind by any of the parties hereto.

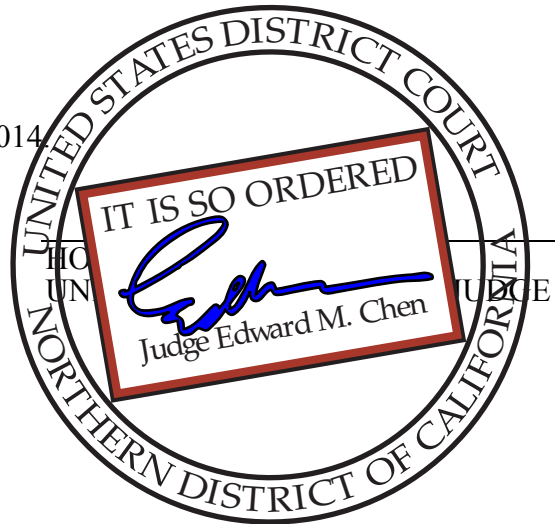
1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**
