The Court is in receipt of HP shareholder Morris Akerman’s motion for an order vacating the order appointing derivative lead plaintiff and lead counsel and setting a briefing schedule for the filing of new motions to appoint derivative lead plaintiff and lead counsel (dkt. 265). Concurrently pending is a motion for preliminary approval of the Third Amended and Restated Stipulation of Settlement (dkt. 277), on which the Court has yet to rule.
